ORDER

By this Order, the commission orders that certificate of public convenience and necessity number 1797-C ("Certificate No. 1797-C"), held by YEHIA M. EL-HELOUEH, dba YAYA TAXI ("Petitioner"), is terminated, effective from the date of this Order.

I.

Request to Surrender Common Carrier Authority

On February 10, 2005, Petitioner filed a letter requesting commission approval to voluntarily surrender his authority under Certificate No. 1797-C. Under Certificate No. 1797-C, Petitioner is authorized to transport passengers by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the 1-to-7 passenger classification.

II.

Findings and Conclusions

In accordance with Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") § 271-19, operating authority under a certificate of public convenience and necessity may be terminated upon application of the holder. The commission finds good cause to grant Petitioner's request to terminate his authority.


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
THE COMMISSION ORDERS:


1. Petitioner's authority to transport passengers under Certificate No. 1797-C is terminated, effective from the date of this Order.
2. Petitioner shall remove any markings from the vehicles used in his operations. Petitioner shall comply with the foregoing requirement within 15 days from the date of this Order.
3. If Petitioner fails to comply with the foregoing requirement within the time period specified, he may be subject to penalties pursuant to HRS § 271-27.


