ORDER AND NOTICE OF HEARING

The commission approves the Parties' requests to change or re-schedule: (1) the deadline for NORTH SHORE WASTEWATER TREATMENT, L.L.C. ("NSWT"), and its predecessor-in-interest, KUILIMA RESORT COMPANY ("KRC"), to file their direct testimonies and exhibits, from October 11, 2005 to October 25, 2005; (2) the prehearing conference, from October 14, 2005, 9:00 a.m., to November 10, 2005, 9:00 a.m.; and (3) the Order to Show Cause hearing, from October 26, 2005, 9:00 a.m., to November 15, 2005, 9:00 a.m.<sup>1</sup>

The Parties, through NSWT and KRC, request to change or re-schedule certain dates, by letter dated October 5, 2005:

Because the [Consumer Advocate] had previously scheduled certain technical meetings in Hawaii between its mainland consultant and a public utility beginning on the week of

October 24<sup>th</sup>, the Consumer Advocate is unable to attend the show cause hearing on October 26, 2005. It is our understanding that November 15, 17, or 18 are the next available dates the Commission has available for the show cause hearing. Because of the push back in the schedule, it is the [P]arties' understanding that the prehearing conference and the filing date for the direct testimony should also be moved back accordingly.<sup>2</sup>

The commission, upon a finding of good cause shown, approves the Parties' requests to change or re-schedule: (1) the deadline for NSWTT and KRC to file their direct testimonies and exhibits, from October 11, 2005 to October 25, 2005; (2) the prehearing conference, from October 14, 2005, 9:00 a.m., to November 10, 2005, 9:00 a.m., at the commission's conference room; and (3) the Order to Show Cause hearing, from October 26, 2005, 9:00 a.m., to November 15, 2005, 9:00 a.m., at the commission's hearing room.<sup>3</sup>

THE COMMISSION ORDERS that, consistent with the terms of this Order: (1) the deadline for NSWTT and KRC to file their direct testimonies and exhibits is changed from October 11, 2005 to October 25, 2005; (2) the prehearing conference is re-scheduled from October 14, 2005, 9:00 a.m., to November 10, 2005, 9:00 a.m., at the commission's conference room; and (3) the Order to Show Cause hearing is re-scheduled from October 26,

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




