ORDER

By this order, the commission: (1) approves Hess Microgen, LLC's ("Hess Microgen") withdrawal from this proceeding; (2) dismisses Johnson Controls, Inc. ("JCI") as a Party; and (3) amends the regulatory schedule for this proceeding.

I. Discussion

A. Hess Microgen's Notice of Withdrawal

On September 19, 2005, Hess Microgen filed a notice of withdrawal in this docket. The commission approves Hess Microgen's withdrawal from this proceeding.

B. Dismissal of JCI

On June 16, 2005, the commission filed a Notice of Intent to Dismiss Johnson Controls, Inc. ("JCI") as a Party to this proceeding because JCI had failed to participate in this proceeding in accordance with the commission's orders and its

continued involvement as a Party would unduly delay the proceeding. JCI has not filed any written objection to the commission's Notice of Dismissal. Accordingly, the commission dismisses JCI as a Party to this proceeding.

C. Scheduling Order

Due to scheduling conflicts, the commission amends the regulatory schedule by moving the panel hearings from the week of October 17, 2005, to the week of December 12, 2005. The Parties¹ notified the commission's staff that they do not object to this schedule change.

On September 20, 2005, Hawaiian Electric Company, Inc. ("HECO"), with the concurrence of all Parties, requested that the regulatory schedule be amended as follows:

Simultaneous Information Requests to the Parties and Active Participants on their Final Position Statements, Exhibits and Workpapers.	From Thursday, September 22, 2005 to Tuesday, October 18, 2005.
Simultaneous Responses to Information Requests filed by the Parties and Active Participants on the Parties/Active Participants' Final Position Statements, Exhibits, and Workpapers.	From Thursday, October 6, 2005 to Tuesday, November 22, 2005.
Prehearing Conference.	From Tuesday, October 11, 2005 to Tuesday, November 29, 2005.

¹ Hawaiian Electric Company, Inc., Hawaii Electric Light Company, Inc., Maui Electric Company, Limited, Kauai Island Utility Cooperative, Hawaii Renewable Energy Alliance, and County of Kauai.

Because the commission is moving the panel hearings to the week of December 12, 2005, the commission finds the changes requested by HECO reasonable and approves HECO's proposed schedule changes.

II. Orders

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. Hess Microgen's withdrawal from this proceeding is approved.
2. JCI is dismissed as a Party to this Proceeding.
3. The regulatory schedule for this proceeding is amended as set forth in this order.
