ORDER

By this Order, the commission orders that the application filed by MESH I DAVIS, dba INNOVATIVE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES OF THE BIG ISLAND ("Applicant"), on May 27, 2005, and amended on July 5, 2005, is dismissed without prejudice and this docket is closed.

I.

Application for Common Carrier Authority

By application filed on May 27, 2005, and amended on July 5, 2005, Applicant requested a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a common carrier of passengers by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Hawaii, excluding Waipio Valley, in the 1-to-7 passenger classification.

By a notice of dismissal dated December 21, 2005, we informed Applicant of our intent to dismiss the application without prejudice because of Applicant's failure to respond to

the commission's request for information. Applicant was further advised that any objection to the dismissal of her application must be submitted in writing and filed not later than ten (10) days from the date of the notice, and that if an objection was not filed, the commission would issue an order dismissing the application.

II.

Findings and Conclusions

Applicant did not object to the dismissal of her application within the ten (10)-day time period. We, thus, find that there is good cause to dismiss the application in this docket.

III.

Order




