ORDER

I.

On October 14, 2005, MENLO WORLDWIDE FORWARDING, INC. ("Transferor") filed an application seeking temporary approval to transfer certificate of public convenience and necessity number 2136-C ("Certificate No. 2136-C") to UPS CARTAGE SERVICES, INC. ("Transferee"). The application is made pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes § 271-18(f). On October 14, 2005, Transferor also filed an application for permanent approval to transfer Certificate No. 2136-C to Transferee in Docket No. 05-0259.

By Decision and Order No. 22287, filed on February 16, 2006, in Docket No. 05-0259, we granted Transferor's request for permanent approval to transfer Certificate No. 2136-C to Transferee. Having granted the transfer of Certificate No. 2136-C to transferee on a permanent basis, we have rendered moot the instant application for temporary approval of the

transfer. We, thus, conclude that there is good cause to dismiss the application herein.

1. The application in this docket, having been rendered moot, is dismissed.

2. This docket is closed unless otherwise ordered by the commission.


