

On September 29, 2004, Respondent filed its 2003 AFR, paid its Fee, and paid \$143.19 in penalties and interest that the commission assessed, pursuant to HRS § 271-27(i) and HAR §§ 6-62-24(b)(c) and 6-62-42(d).

The commission finds that Respondent has fully complied, although belatedly, with the motor carrier laws, rules, and regulations, and concludes that Order No. 21251, filed on September 7, 2004, should be vacated.

III.


Orders


