THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. Applicant's request to surrender his authority in the 1-to-7 passenger classification is granted.

2. Decision and Order No. 22189 is amended consistent with the terms of this Order. Specifically, ordering paragraph 1 in Decision and Order No. 22189 is amended as follows:

"Applicant is granted a Certificate to operate as a common carrier of property by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the 8-to-25 passenger classification."

In all other respects, Decision and Order No. 22189 remains unchanged.
