ORDER

I.

Request to Place Common Carrier Authority on Inactive Status

On September 23, 2005, MAUI OFF-ROAD AND SHORELINE FISHING TOURS, INC. ("Petitioner") filed a letter requesting that certificate of public convenience and necessity no. 4830-C ("Certificate No. 4830-C") be placed on inactive status. Certificate No. 4830-C authorizes Petitioner to transport passengers by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Maui in the 1-to-7 passenger classification.

By letter dated October 18, 2005, the commission requested that Petitioner file an annual financial report ("AFR") and associated motor carrier gross revenue fee ("Fee") for the period January 1, 2005 to the date of its request for inactive status. Petitioner failed to file the AFR and pay the requisite Fee. Accordingly, by Order No. 22681, filed on August 3, 2006, in Docket No. 2006-0246, the commission ordered Petitioner to appear before the commission on September 27, 2006, to show cause why

Certificate No. 4830-C should not be revoked for failure to file an AFR and pay a Fee for the year 2005. As Petitioner failed to appear at the hearing, the commission issued Decision and Order No. 23032 on November 21, 2006, which revoked Certificate No. 4830-C for Petitioner's failure to file an AFR and pay a Fee for the year 2005.

The revocation of Petitioner's operating authority renders moot Petitioner's request to place Certificate No. 4830-C on inactive status. Thus, we conclude that there is good cause to dismiss the petition in this docket.

II.

Order

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

The petition filed on September 23, 2005, is dismissed and this docket is closed unless otherwise ordered by the commission.
