ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

By this Order, the commission closes this docket.

I.

Closing of the Docket

By Decision and Order No. 24169, filed on April 30, 2008, the commission approved the application jointly filed by SPRINTCOM, INC. ("Sprintcom") and NPCR, INC. ("NPCR"),¹ to amend the eligible telecommunications carrier ("ETC") designation granted to NPCR, by including Sprintcom in the non-rural telephone company areas where NPCR was previously designated, i.e., the areas served by Hawaiian Telcom, Inc. In addition, the commission instructed Sprintcom to file the following information by May 12, 2008: a point of contact to

address any customer service or service quality complaints received by the commission; a map showing the areas in which it is designated an ETC; an informational tariff incorporating the rates, terms, and conditions for its Lifeline service offering and its Link Up discounts; and its detailed advertising plan for the provision of the core services, including the content and manner of its planned advertisements, and the targeted consumers.²

On May 12, 2008, Applicants timely filed the required information, in accordance with Decision and Order No. 24169.³ Having complied with the commission's directive, the commission closes this docket.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:


This docket is closed unless ordered otherwise by the commission.


