ORDER VACATING DECISION AND ORDER NO. 24117

By this Order, the commission vacates Decision and Order No. 24117 and closes this docket.

I.

Application for Common Carrier Authority

On March 31, 2008, in Decision and Order No. 24117, the commission approved the application of HYANG HEE PAK ("Applicant") to extend her authority under certificate of public convenience and necessity number 1843-C to include the 8-to-25 passenger classification on the island of Hawaii, excluding Waipio Valley. We also: (1) ordered Applicant, as a condition to our approval of the application, to comply with all commission requirements for common carriers, including submitting certain documents within one hundred and twenty (120) days of the issuance of the decision and order; and (2) notified Applicant that failure to timely comply with the commission's requirements would constitute cause for the commission to vacate the Decision and Order. We served Applicant with a copy of the Decision and

Order by mail, postage prepaid, on the same day that the Decision and Order was issued, in accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rules §§ 6-61-21 and 6-61-122.

II.

Findings and Conclusions

The one hundred and twenty (120)-day time period has passed, and Applicant has not complied with the requirements set forth in Decision and Order No. 24117. The commission, thus, determines that Decision and Order No. 24117 should be vacated.

III.

Order

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

Decision and Order No. 24117 is vacated and this docket is closed unless otherwise ordered by the commission.
