ORDER AMENDING DECISION AND ORDER, FILED JUNE 18, 2008

I.

Request to Amend Common Carrier Authority

By the commission's Decision and Order, filed on June 18, 2008, DERICK E. GOMES, dba KAIMANA SERVICES ("Applicant"), was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a common carrier of property by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the general commodities classification.

On July 17, 2008, Applicant filed a letter stating that he had mistakenly applied for the wrong classification and requested that his application be amended to indicate that he is requesting the dump truck classification. Accordingly, we find good cause to grant Applicant's request to amend his application to indicate that he is requesting the dump truck classification in lieu of the general commodities classification.

Based upon our review of the record, the commission finds that Applicant is fit, willing, and able to properly perform as a common carrier in the dump truck classification, and

to conform to HRS Chapter 271 and the requirements and rules of the commission. The commission also finds that the proposed service as a common carrier in the dump truck classification is required by the present and future public convenience and necessity. Accordingly, the commission concludes that Applicant's request for operating authority in the dump truck classification should be granted.

II.

<u>Orders</u>

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 1. Applicant's request to amend his application to indicate that he is requesting the dump truck classification in lieu of the general commodities classification is granted.
- 2. The commission's Decision and Order, filed on June 18, 2008, is amended consistent with the terms of this Order. Specifically, ordering paragraph 1 in our Decision and Order is amended as follows:

"Applicant is granted a Certificate to operate as a common carrier of property by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Oahu in the dump truck classification."
