DECISION AND ORDER

By this Decision and Order, the commission vacates the Notice of Violation, Order to Show Cause, and Notice of Hearing ("Notice"), filed on October 15, 2008, in the matter of LOREEN D. TROXEL, dba THC TRANSERVICE ("Respondent").

I.

History

By Notice, filed on October 15, 2008, the commission ordered Respondent to appear at 465 South King Street, Room B-3, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813, at 9:00 a.m., on November 19, 2008, to show cause why Respondent's certificate of public convenience and necessity number 1934-C should not be suspended or revoked for failure to file an annual financial report ("AFR") and pay an annual motor carrier gross revenue fee ("Fee") for the year 2007, pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") §§ 271-25, 271-36,

and Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") §§ 6-62-42(a), 6-62-24(a).

On October 16, 2008, Respondent filed its 2007 AFR, paid its Fee, and paid \$56.05 in penalties and interest that the commission assessed, pursuant to HRS § 271-27(i), and HAR §§ 6-62-24(b)(c) and 6-62-42(d).

II.

Findings and Conclusions

The commission finds that Respondent has fully complied, although belatedly, with the motor carrier laws, rules, and regulations, and concludes that the Notice, filed on October 15, 2008, should be vacated.

Orders

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:


1. The Notice, filed on October 15, 2008, is vacated.
2. This docket is closed unless otherwise ordered by the commission.


