DECISION AND ORDER

By this Decision and Order, the commission authorizes R. REGO TRUCKING, LLC ("Applicant") to extend its authority under certificate of public convenience and necessity number 3047-C ("Certificate No. 3047-C") to include the general commodities and household goods classifications on the island of Kauai, subject to certain conditions, as described herein.

I.

Application to Extend Common Carrier Authority

Applicant is a common carrier of property by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the island of Kauai in the dump truck and specific commodities (heavy machinery and equipment, and specialized equipment) classifications. On July 14, 2009, Applicant filed an application seeking commission approval to extend its authority under Certificate No. 3047-C to include the general commodities and household goods classifications on the island of Kauai.

Applicant served copies of the application on the Hawaii Transportation Association, which consists of carriers that may be affected by Applicant's proposed service, and on the Division of Consumer Advocacy, Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs ("Consumer Advocate"). The Consumer Advocate did not participate in this proceeding, and no persons moved to intervene in this docket.

II.

Findings and Conclusions

Based upon our review of the record, the commission finds that Applicant is fit, willing, and able to properly perform the proposed service, and to conform to Hawaii Revised Statutes Chapter 271 and the requirements and rules of the commission. The commission also finds that the proposed service is required by the present and future public convenience and necessity. Accordingly, the commission concludes that Applicant's request for an extension of its authority should be granted.

III.

Orders

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. Applicant is authorized to operate as a common carrier of property by motor vehicle over irregular routes on the

island of Kauai in the general commodities, household goods, and dump truck classifications.¹

2. Within one hundred and twenty (120) days after service of this Decision and Order, Applicant shall:

- a. File a Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc. ("WMTB") tariff scope sheet that reflects Applicant's new authority in the general commodities and household goods classifications on the island of Kauai.²

3. Applicant shall comply with the foregoing requirement within one hundred and twenty (120) days after service of this Decision and Order. Failure to comply within the time specified may constitute cause for this commission to vacate this Decision and Order.

4. Applicant shall not commence operations in the general commodities and household goods classifications until it has received written confirmation from the commission that all requirements have been met.

¹Applicant's specific commodities authority is subsumed under its general commodities authority.




