Plaintiff having filed a First Motion for Relief Pursuant to the Stipulated Permanent Injunction and Final Judgment Against Defendant Honolulu University of Arts, Sciences and Humanities on May 10, 2004; the matter having come on for hearing before the Honorable Sabrina S. McKenna on May 27, 2004 at 10:00 o'clock a.m.; Plaintiff having been represented by Jeffrey E.
