IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Business

Registration Division of the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs of the State of Hawaii shall and is hereby ordered to dissolve, terminate, revoke and/or

cancel, all trademarks, corporate registrations (including that for University of Advanced Research-Hawaii Campus, Ltd.) and certificates of authority held by or for any of the defendants.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendants University of Advanced Research-Hawaii Campus, Ltd. and Frederick A. Mitchell, their agents, employees, successors and assigns, directly or indirectly, individually or in concert with others, or through any corporate or other device, be and are hereby permanently enjoined from:

- a. Providing any post-secondary instructional programs or courses
 leading to a degree;
- Acting as or holding themselves out as a "college, academy, institute, institution, university" or anything similar thereto;
- c. Failing to comply with Hawaii Rev. Stat. Chap. 446E or § 480-2(a) in any particulars; and
- d. Owning or operating any business in the State of Hawaii or claiming to operate under the laws of the State of Hawaii until all restitution, civil penalties and costs entered herein are fully satisfied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendants
University of Advanced Research-Hawaii Campus, Ltd. and Frederick A. Mitchell
shall, jointly and severally, implement a restitution program as follows. Defendants
University of Advanced Research be and are hereby ordered to immediately compile a
list of those students who enrolled in or graduated from University of Advanced
Research subsequent to July 1, 1999 and to send a written offer of restitution to

each such individual in the appropriate form attached as Exhibits 1 or 2. Defendants be and are hereby ordered, adjudged and decreed to make restitution to anyone requesting it within twenty days of the receipt of such a request.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that, pursuant to Hawaii Rev. Stat. § 480-3.1, Defendant University of Advanced Research-Hawaii Campus, Ltd. be and hereby is liable to Plaintiff for civil penalties in the amount of \$125,000.00.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that, pursuant to Hawaii Rev. Stat. § 480-3.1, Defendant Frederick A. Mitchell be and hereby is liable to Plaintiff for civil penalties in the amount of \$125,000.

The only remaining claims are Defendant Frederick A. Mitchell's Counterclaims against the Plaintiff.
