Executive Officer's Report:

Executive Officer Bhanot reported the following statistics for the December 2011 Renewals for Chiropractor licenses as of 2/1/12:

The online renewal statistics do not include the active/inactive status change renewals that require the submission of a hard copy. The deadline for renewals this year was 1/3/12. Licensees who do not renew their license have 2 (two) years to restore their license with proof of 20 hours of CE credits. The CE random audit will randomly select 5% of the chiropractors with active licenses and will be conducted after the renewal period.

c. Council on Chiropractic Education (CCE)

The Board reviewed the February 8, 2012 email from the CCE regarding Accreditation Actions – January 2012 Annual Council Meeting. The CCE conducted reviews regarding various reports submitted by CCE-accredited Doctor of Chiropractic Degree Programs and the Board was informed of the accreditation actions taken by the council.

d. Yellow Pages Advertisement

The Board discussed and responded to Dr. Pleiss and Dr. Opie questions as follows:

1. Dr. Pleiss inquired about the procedures for questionable advertisement in the Yellow Pages when a Board Member sees advertisement in the Yellow Pages.

DAG Tsang stated that enforcement is done by Regulated Industries Complaints Office (RICO) and the Board member may bring their concerns to Executive Officer Bhanot to generate a staff initiated complaint to RICO to investigate.

2. Dr. Opie inquired if Hawaii has any rules that the advertisement includes the full-name of the chiropractor in the Yellow Pages.

DAG Tsang stated a copy of the current license certificate shall be prominently displayed at all times in the office where the chiropractor is employed or practices.
