Correspondence:

a. October 13, 2011 email from the Board of Barbering and Cosmetology regarding scope of practice.

The Board reviewed the email from the Board of Barbering and Cosmetology asking if a licensed esthetician can perform waxing services in the office of a chiropractor. The Board of Barbering and Cosmetology rules provides for an exemption for persons employed by health care facilities if the waxing falls within the scope of practice of a chiropractor.

Dr. Klein stated there is nothing in the law that indicates the procedure is included in the chiropractic scope of practice.

After further discussion, the Board concluded that waxing for the removal of superfluous hair is **not** included in Hawaii Revised Statutes Chapter 442-1 Chiropractic defined.
