Call to Order: There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by Dr. Klein at 9:20 a.m.

Approval of
Meeting Minutes: Minutes of the November 1, 2012 Board Meeting

It was moved by Ms. Kang-Kaulupali, seconded by Dr. Redmond, and unanimously carried to approve the minutes of November 1, 2012 as circulated.

Chairperson's
Report:

A. Feedback from the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners regarding the Ethics and Boundaries Essay Examination.

Dr. Klein indicated that he did not receive feedback from the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners ("NBCE") regarding the Ethics and Boundaries Essay Examination when he attended the NBCE Part IV Exam in November 2012.

Dr. Klein stated that he has great confidence with the NBCE in improving the chiropractic profession and education.

Executive Officer's Report:

A. Council on Chiropractic Education (CCE)

1. December 4, 2012 CCE Announcement regarding public comments to the draft language of the Preface of the CCE Accreditation Standards.

Executive Officer Bhanot informed members that during the November 29, 2012 meeting, the CCE Consensus Committee unanimously agreed to recommend draft language to be incorporated into the Preface of the CCE Accreditation Standards.

Executive Officer Bhanot advised the Board that CCE has requested public comments to the draft language for review and action by the Council at its January 2013 Annual Meeting.

2. December 5, 2012 CCE email regarding Recommendations from Consensus Committee Meeting – November 29, 2012.

Executive Officer Bhanot distributed to the Board the recommended draft language from the Consensus Committee. She explained that the charge to the committee was to develop mutually agreeable language to incorporate into the Foreword (Preface) to the CCE accreditation standards that acknowledges the scope of practice and identity of the chiropractic profession.

Ms. Kang-Kaulupali inquired as to how the draft language will affect Hawaii's law.

Dr. Klein indicated that he does not think it will affect the current law. He went on to say that the language clarifies and expands chiropractic in general.

Licensing:

A. Ratifications of Issued License

It was moved by Dr. Redmond, seconded by Ms. Kang-Kaulupali, and unanimously carried to ratify the above staff approval of licensee(s).

It was moved by Dr. Redmond, seconded by Ms. Kang-Kaulupali, and unanimously carried to not grant Douglas W. Dragan, D.C. request to waive the SPEC Examination offered by the NBCE and to deny his application.

Correspondence: A. December 14, 2012 email from Terry McDonald of Texas Chiropractic College Re: Dr. Cessna Website

The Board received an email from Terry McDonald of Texas Chiropractic College notifying the Board that they do not have any ongoing relationship with Cessna Consulting. As such, they asked Cessna Consulting to remove their name and phone number from their web site.

A. December 21, 2012 email from Carmen Pang of Pacific Blue Cross Re: Cellular Regeneration

The Board reviewed and discussed the above email inquiry dated December 21, 2012 from Carmen Pang. Ms. Pang inquired if cellular regeneration is within the scope of practice for chiropractors in Hawaii.

Discussion followed. The Board interpreted the term "cellular regeneration" to be broad. It was moved by Dr. Klein, seconded by Ms. Kang-Kaulupali, and unanimously carried to defer a decision and request specific information and clarification from Carmen Pang on the definition of cellular regeneration.

The Board will discuss this further at the next scheduled Board meeting on Thursday, March 7, 2013.
