

**IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING**  
**THE HAWAII BOARD OF DENTAL EXAMINERS ("BOARD")**  
**DENTAL LICENSURE EXAMINATION**

DENTISTS

Pursuant to Act 72, Session Laws Hawaii, 2007, the examination for dental licensure in Hawaii is the ADEX dental examination ("ADEX"). Applicants for dental licensure can register with the North East Regional Board of Dental Examiners, Inc. ("NERB") to take the ADEX. In addition, effective 2013, ADEX will also be administered by the Southern Regional Testing Agency, Inc. ("SRTA"), Nevada Board of Dental Examiners. Effective 2013, ADEX will consist of four required sections and one optional section. The four required sections consist of the following: 1) Computer-based Diagnostic Skills Examination ("DSE"), 2) Manikin-based Endodontic Clinical Examination, 3) Manikin-based Fixed Prosthodontic Clinical Examination; and Patient-based Restorative Clinical Examination. The optional section consists of the Patient-based Periodontal Clinical Examination.

Please be aware that to become licensed in Hawaii, all five sections must be passed. This includes the Patient-based Periodontal Clinical Examination.
