Michael E. Hegmann, M.D.

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Dr. Barrickman, seconded by Dr. Desai and unanimously carried to defer Dr. Hegmann's application for medical licensure pending receipt of a detailed statement of explanation to a "yes" response.

Miratiqullah Hessami, M.D.

It was moved by Dr. Sept, seconded by Dr. Kosasa and unanimously carried to defer Dr. Hessami's application for medical licensure pending the receipt of a detailed statement.

Claudia R. Mondragon, D.O.

The Board reviewed and considered all of the records and files of Dr. Mondragon's application including information from her as well as from other organizations. After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Dr. Kosasa, seconded by Dr. Desai and unanimously carried to deny Dr. Mondragon's application for medical licensure, basing its decision on the following legal grounds in the HRS, which find factual support in the records and files of Dr. Mondragon's application:

HRS § 453-8(a)(7): Professional misconduct, hazardous negligence causing bodily injury to another, or manifest incapacity in the practice of medicine, osteopathy, or surgery;

HRS § 453-8(a)(8): Incompetence or multiple instances of negligence, including but not limited to the consistent use of medical service, which is inappropriate or unnecessary;

HRS § 453-8(a)(9): Conduct or practice contrary to recognized standards of ethics of the medical profession as adopted by the Hawaii Medical

Association, the American Medical Association, the Hawaii Association of Osteopathic Physicians and Surgeons, or the American Osteopathic Association; and

HRS § 436B-19(8): Failure to maintain a record or history of competency, trustworthiness, fair dealing, and financial integrity.

Alexei M. Zhadkevich, M.D.

The Board reviewed and considered all of the records and files of Dr. Zhadkevich's application including information from him as well as from other organizations. These records and files reflect, but are not limited to: 1) Dr. Zhadkevich's failure to disclose his resignation from the Massachusetts General Hospital, General Surgery Residency Program ; and 2) information from the Residency Program which indicates that Dr. Zhadkevich has significant deficits in multiple core competencies of the Accreditation Council on Graduate Medical Education .

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Dr. Desai, seconded by Dr. Kosasa and unanimously carried to deny Dr. Zhadkevich's application for licensure, basing its decision on the following legal grounds of the HRS, which find factual support in the records and files of his application:

HRS § 453-8(a)(6): Procuring a license through fraud, misrepresentation, or deceit, or knowingly permitting an unlicensed person to perform activities requiring a license;

HRS § 453-8(a)(7): Professional misconduct, hazardous negligence causing bodily injury to another, or manifest incapacity in the practice of medicine, osteopathy, or surgery;

HRS § 453-8(a)(8): Incompetence or multiple instances of negligence, including but not limited to the consistent use of medical service, which is inappropriate or unnecessary;

HRS § 453-8(a)(9): Conduct or practice contrary to recognized standards of ethics of the medical profession as adopted by the Hawaii Medical Association, the American Medical

Association, the Hawaii Association of Osteopathic Physicians and Surgeons, or the American Osteopathic Association; and

HRS § 436B-19(8): Failure to maintain a record or history of competency, trustworthiness, fair dealing, and financial integrity.

New Business: b. Legislation: Summary Suspension and Physical/Mental Evaluation

Daria Loy-Goto, RICO's Complaints Enforcement Officer, appeared before the Board to brief them on the above matter.

The Board reviewed RICO's proposed legislation, a Bill for an Act to amend HRS Chapter 453 by adding new provisions which would 1) authorize the Board to summarily suspend a license via a separate law from HRS Chapter 436B which pertains to all DCCA boards and commissions, and; and 2) order a license to submit a physical and mental examination under specific circumstances.

a. Kelley Withy, M.D.: Report on Physician Workforce Assessment

Kelley Withy, MD, PhD, University of Hawaii John A. Burns School of Medicine appeared before the Board. She distributed to the Board a report on findings from the Hawaii Physician Workforce Assessment Project.

Dr. Withy explained the findings and advised the Board on possible solutions being implemented by the physician workforce team. She further advised of the progress made to date.

Discussion followed.

Mr. Cody thanked Dr. Withy for appearing before the Board.

It was moved by Dr. Kosasa, seconded by Dr. Bintliff, and unanimously carried to enter into executive session at 2:31 p.m. pursuant to Section 92-5(a)(4), HRS, to consult with the Board's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities and liabilities.
