Call to Order: With the presence of quorum, Chairperson Chow called the meeting

to order at 9:33 a.m.

Welcome New

Chairperson Chow welcomed new member Swee Berkey and asked **Board Member**: her to give a brief summary of her background. Ms. Berkey is a law

Meeting:

It was moved by Mr. Sasuga, seconded by Mr. Hirakawa, and unanimously carried to approve the minutes as circulated.

The Executive Officer informed the members that the meeting schedule for 2012 is being worked on now, and asked the members if they are okay with the current meeting day and time. By consensus, members agreed that the current meeting day and time are fine.

The Executive Officer reported that board meeting minutes are now posted on-line for public access.

Chapter 91, HRS, Adjudicatory Matters:

The Chairperson called for a recess from the meeting at 9:48 a.m. to deliberate on the following adjudicatory matter, pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") Chapter 91.

In the Matter of the Motor Vehicle Repair Licenses of WESTERN

MOTORS SERV INC., and ELVIN K. KAIAKAPU, Respondents; ARP 201064-L – Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary

Action and Board's Final Order

Deputy Attorney General Tam briefly summarized the above matter and a discussion followed.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Sasuga, seconded by Mr. Higa, and unanimously carried to approve the settlement agreement, in which:

1. Respondents do not admit to violating any law or rule, and enter into this settlement agreement as a compromise of the claims and to conserve the expense of a hearing.

### 2. <u>Terms of Settlement</u>

- Respondents agree to pay a fine in the amount of FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$500.00).
- If Respondents fail to fully and timely pay the fine as set forth in this settlement agreement, Respondents' licenses shall be automatically revoked upon RICO's filing of an affidavit with the Board attesting to such failure. In case of

such revocation, Respondents understand that Respondents cannot apply for a new license until the expiration of at least five (5) years after the effective date of the revocation. Respondents understand that if Respondents desire to become licensed again, Respondents must apply to the Board for new licenses pursuant to and subject to HRS §§92-17, 436B-21 and all other applicable laws and rules in effect at that time.

At 9:54 a.m., the Chairperson announced that the Board would return to its regular order of business.

### Licensing: Applications – None.

### Ratification

The Board members reviewed the ratification lists for motor vehicle repair dealer and motor vehicle mechanic licenses. Upon a motion by Mr. Sasuga, seconded by Mr. Higa, it was unanimously carried to ratify the lists (attached).

### **New Business:**

RICO Motor Vehicle Repair Advisory Committee - 2010 Term and Addendum Language

Board members reviewed the list of advisory committee members and the addendum language. Upon a motion by Mr. Sasuga, seconded by Ms. Berkey, it was unanimously carried to approve the list and the addendum language (attached).

### <u>Unfinished</u> Business:

Mr. Higa asked the Executive Officer the status on the suspensions of the motor vehicle dealer's license of Kinoole Auto Care, Inc. and the motor vehicle mechanic's license of Ralph E. Fujiyama. He wanted to know if the shop was still in business or had been closed. The Executive Officer stated that she did not know; that it is assumed that the respondents are in compliance with the terms of the Board's Final Order. Once the final order is issued it is assumed that the Respondents are in compliance with the order.

# Other Organizations:

Discussions continued on the existing contract with HCC regarding the motor vehicle certification program.

The Executive Officer stated that the contract is between the Board and UH to provide services under the motor vehicle certification program. HCC has had a difficult time keeping up with the terms of the contract, and they quit leaving the staff little time to look into what is needed to replace them. UH Office of Research Service Contract Specialist indicates that the Board, not UH, would be required to locate a program and principal investigator to oversee the contract. Further, that UH will not enter into a contract without both the program and the principal investigator.

Board members discussed that this would be a good time for the Board to review the contract to see if the terms are out of date, and it could be that UH is not needed any more. The Board may consider looking at changing the law to delete the UH requirement from the statute. There was further discussion about whether proposed legislation of this nature would fit in with the current administration's philosophy.
