Executive Officer's Report: **2013 Legislature – Status Report on Nursing Bills**

The EO reported on the status of the following measures:

SB 490, SD2/HB 654, HD2 – Relating to Nursing

Amendments were made to both bills to change "required" to "request" in regards to the completion of the workforce survey during the renewal of a nurse's license.

SB 198/HB 79, HD1 – Relating to Advanced Practice Registered Nurses

Both bills crossed over to the other side unamended.

SR 34, SCR 66/HR 35, HCR 53 – Requesting Collaboration Among Various State Agencies to Identify Barriers Relating to the Practice of Advanced Practice Registered Nursing to the Full Extent of the Nurses' Education and Training in the State

After some discussion, it was the consensus of the Board to support SR 34, SCR 55, HR 35, and HCR 53.

Conferences/Seminars/Meetings

Ms. Elvenia – Report on Attendance at Annual Institute of Regulatory Excellence (IRE) Conference

Ms. Elvenia attended the 3 day Annual IRE Conference in New Orleans. She reported on her attendance of ten sessions spread over a two day period. The Alternative to Discipline Program was the most favored. It is a Florida self referral program. There was also a presentation by Jenny Driver, who works with the FBI and CIA entitled, "You can't lie to me". Ms. Driver teaches agencies how to tell if someone is lying to you.

Upcoming Renewal

Renewal of Rx Authority for APRN-Rx – Status Report

The EO reported that the nurse renewals will go live in mid April 2013. A memo to all the APRN-Rxs was mailed informing them how the proposed changes to the administrative rules may affect the renewal of their APRN license and encouraging the APRN-Rxs to submit their continuing education ("CE") as soon as possible. She reported that approximately 30 APRN-Rxs have submitted their CEs out of a 400 +.

Correspondence

Nurses Administering Botox and Dermal Fillers, Dr. Michael Dang

The Board reviewed an email from Dr. Dang, referred by the Board of Dental Examiners regarding the administering of botox and dermal fillers by a nurse. In his email, Dr. Dang states that a nurse administers botox and dermal fillers and that nurses are approved by the Board to perform such tasks.

After some discussion, the Board would like to clarify their previous determination that the administering of botox is not considered part of the nursing scope of practice since it is not a procedure that is part of the curriculum in a nurse's formal educational preparation. The Board does not endorse any specific procedure and declines to comment or decide on the appropriateness of specific procedures in particular work settings.

The Board would also like to refer Dr. Dang of the definition of the practice of nursing as a registered nurse under Hawaii Revised Statutes, Section ("HRS") 457-2 that allows a registered nurse ("RN") to use of reasonable judgment in carrying out prescribed medical orders of a licensed dentist, physician, osteopathic physician, etc..

This is an informal interpretation for informational and explanatory purposes only and is not an official opinion or decision and therefore is not to be viewed as binding on the Board and is not to be construed as authorizing any practitioner to perform outside of his or her scope of practice.

Family Nurse Practitioner Administering Botox and Fillers, Jennifer Lee

The Board reviewed an email from Ms. Lee inquiring if a Family NP, who has received training and certification to administer botox and filler by an accredited institution and under a trained physician, can administer botox and filler.

After some discussion, the Board reaffirmed their previous decision regarding a Family Nurse Practitioner administering botox and filler. The Board's informal interpretation is that the administering of botox is not part of the nursing scope of practice as it is not a procedure that is part of the curriculum in a nurse's formal educational preparation and is not part of an APRN formulary.

The current formulary is exclusionary and Board does not endorse specific drugs. The Board does not endorse any specific procedure and declines to comment or decide on the appropriateness of specific procedures in particular work settings.

The Board also refers Ms. Lee to HRS section 457-2, which defines the practice of nursing as a registered nurse and section 457-2.7, which defines the practice of an APRN.

Psychiatric Examination Report (DHS 1271) – Dept. of Human Services Refusal to Accept APRN Signature, Clair Rausch

The Board reviewed an email from Ms. Rausch regarding the Department of Human Services' failure to recognize APRN's as having the ability to sign certain documents relating to health care including... "verification and evaluation forms of the department of human services...".

After some discussion, the Board wishes to inform Ms. Rausch about resolutions HR 35/HCR 53 and SR 34/SCR 66, previously discussed, that will hopefully address this issue.

National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN) – Leadership Succession Committee's 2013 Call for Nominations

The EO asked if the Board had any nominations.

Mr. Kula suggested that since all the members receive the NCSBN newsletter by email, there is no need to distribute a copy to them in their Board packets.

Old Business:

Amendments to HAR Title 16, Chapter 89 – Status Report

The EO reported that the proposed rules will be submitted to the Governor's Office through the Director's Office.

Participation in NURSYS – Status Report

The EO reported in order for Hawaii to participate in NURSYS, we had to provide the licensees social security numbers (SSN). We were planning on adding a question to the renewal application asking the licensees permission to give their SSN to NURSYS.

However, according to a representative from NURSYS, if all licensees do not participate, the integrity of the information provided will not be useful. Therefore, we will not be going forward with asking the licensees for permission to give their SSN's. However, the EO asked the representative from NURSYS for the names of the states that allow release of confidential information and so far have received responses from Washington and Missouri.

Criminal Background Checks

NCSBN is still pushing for criminal background checks as part of the licensure process. NCSBN has offered their help with introducing legislation.

The Chair stated if NCSBN believes it is important, a criminal background check should be a part of the NCLEX examination process.

Hawaii State Center for Nursing ("HSCFN")

The EO reported Dr. Gardner was planning on attending today's meeting, however something came up and she may not be able to make it. Dr. Gardner emailed the EO regarding additional language she wants to add to the joint statement.

The Chair stated this needs to be done right away because the renewals will be coming up next month.

Dr. Kula suggested Ms. Stone Murai be the liason with the HSCFN to get the joint statement completed.

The Chair stated he thinks the joint statement is acceptable and the Board should allow the HSCFN add what they want and to get it posted on the webpage as soon as possible.

After some discussion, working off the draft prepared by Ms. Stone Murai, the DAG recited the following statement as the recommendation from the Board: "Nursing-the most trusted profession, Your renewal fees include \$40 to the Center for Nursing special fund, Which enables the Center to collect nurse workforce data. Please contribute to the Center's workforce data survey."

Upon a motion by the Vice Chair, seconded by Dr. Fleming, it was voted on with the Chair, Vice Chair, Dr. Fleming, Ms. Cohen, Ms. Elvenia, Mr. Kula, and Mr. Hoban voting yes and Ms. Stone Murai abstaining. The motion was adopted.

Page 5, after Ms. Cohen arrives, sentence starting with Ms. Elvenia, correct to read, Ms. Elvenia asked whether the Center considered a template for employers regarding the survey.

Ms. Stone Murai stated on page 2, under Approval of the Minutes, second sentence, replace the word "their" with "new".
