Executive Officers Report: **Addition to Regulated Industries Complaints Office (RICO) Advisory Committee**

The Board considered an addition to the RICO Advisory Committee.

#### **Vermont State Board of Nursing – Decision Tree**

The Board reviewed a "Decision Tree" developed by the Vermont State Board of Nursing. The Decision Tree helps a licensed nursing assistant determine if they may perform a task or activity.

It was the consensus of the Board to refer this Decision Tree to the Practice Committee for their consideration.

Education Committee Report: Ms. Cohen reported on the following:

#### **Annual Reports – Deferred to Board from November 3, 2011 Education Committee Meeting for Decision Making**

##### Kapiolani Community College

Ms. Cohen explained that the Education Committee deferred accepting the annual report for Kapiolani Community College for additional information for their new faculty. She

stated that the additional information was subsequently received and she recommends the Board accept the annual report.

Kauai Community College

Ms. Cohen explained that the Education Committee deferred accepting the annual report for Kauai Community College for additional information for one of their faculty. She stated that additional information was subsequently received and she recommends the Board accept the annual report.

There being no further discussion, upon a motion by Ms. Cohen, seconded by Ms. Stone Murai, it was voted on and unanimously carried to accept the 2010-2011 annual reports for both Kapiolani Community College and Kauai Community College.

University of Phoenix

Ms. Cohen explained that the Education Committee deferred accepting the annual report for the University of Phoenix for additional information for their new faculty and for more information/clarification on their credit equivalencies as indicated in their annual report. She stated that additional information was subsequently received for the faculty, however, more information is needed for one of the instructors and the information regarding the credit equivalencies was not received.

Upon a motion by Ms. Cohen, seconded by Ms. Stone Murai, it was voted on and unanimously carried to inform the University of Phoenix to submit the additional information to complete their annual report by the January 5, 2012 Board meeting.

Kauai Community College

Ms. Cohen explained that the Education Committee deferred accepting the quarterly report for the period covering July – September 2011 for Kauai Community College for additional information on one of their faculty. She stated that the additional information was subsequently received and she recommends the Board accept the annual report.

There being no further discussion, upon a motion by Ms. Cohen, seconded by Ms. Stone Murai, it was voted on and unanimously carried to accept the quarterly report for Kauai Community College for the period covering July – September 2011.

Hawaii Pacific University
