Call to Order: The Chair called the meeting to order at 9:26 a.m. at which time quorum was established.  
The Chair excused Ms. Elvenia from today's meeting. Mr. Hoban was considered absent.

Approval of the Minutes: The Chair called for a motion in regards to the minutes of the December 1, 2011 Regular meeting.

Recommended amendments are as follows to the minutes:

- Page 1, under Approval of the Agenda, item 6.a., it should read "Deferred to the Board from November 3, 2011..."
- Page 3, under Quarterly Report, for Kauai Community College, the last line should read, "She stated that the additional information was subsequently received and she recommends the Board accept the quarterly report."
- Page 6, under Adjudicatory Matters, the last line should read "10:22 a.m.".

Recommended amendments are as follows to the Executive Session minutes:

- Page 2, under McQuigg, Anson M., paragraph 11 should read "licensed".
- Page 3, under 4., the words "you have" should be changed to "he has".
- Page 4, the word "until" should be inserted between the words "deferred" and "further".

There being no further amendments, upon a motion by the Vice Chair, seconded by Ms. Stone Murai, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve the minutes as amended.

Chair's Report:

The Chair presented a lei to Ms. Stone Murai and congratulated her on receiving the 2012 American Academy of Nurse Practitioners Nurse Practitioner Advocate State Award for Excellence. Ms. Stone Murai stated that she wanted to thank Ms. Kathleen Yokouchi, the former Executive Officer for the Board of Nursing for all of her hard work and dedication.

The Chair also wanted to thank Ms. Tiwanak and the Hawaii State Center for Nursing ("Center") for sharing their report to the legislature and that he would like to see the Board and the Center work more closely together in the future and recommended that the Center provide a quarterly report to the Board.

Vice Chair's Report:

The Vice Chair reported that she attended a Board Chair/Member orientation with the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs ("DCCA"). The orientation included speakers from the various divisions within DCCA including the Office of Administrative Hearings, the Regulated Industries Complaints Office and the Director's Office. Other speakers included the Office of the Attorney General and the Ethics Commission.

Executive Officer's Report:

**2012 Legislature**

The EO announced that the 2012 Legislature would be convening on January 18<sup>th</sup> and asked if anyone knew of any legislation being submitted regarding the practice of nursing or amendments to HRS, Chapter 457, to please let her know as soon as possible.

**Conference/Meetings/Seminars**

The Chair asked if anyone was interested in attending the NCSBN Midyear Meeting, March 12-14, 2012, in Chicago, Illinois. Ms. Cohen stated that she would be willing to attend. The Chair stated that if no one else was interested he would be willing to attend.

There being no further volunteers or discussion, it was the consensus of the Board to have Ms. Cohen and the Chair represent the Board at the NCSBN Midyear Meeting.

Education Committee Report:

Ms. Cohen made the following recommendations:

University of Phoenix

Accept the additional information regarding the credit equivalencies, however, the additional information received for Ms. Dreflak is still insufficient to substantiate her clinical nursing experience.

#### Hawaii Pacific University

Accept the quarterly report for the period July – September 2011 with the quarterly report for the period October – December 2011 being due by the February 2, 2012 Board meeting for consideration.

Request that Dean Fuller appear before the Board to respond to questions regarding the last quarterly report submitted.

Upon a motion by Ms. Cohen, seconded by the Vice Chair, it was voted on and unanimously carried to accept the recommendations from the Education Committee Chair as stated above.

#### Correspondence:

#### **Medicare Certified Agency Accepting Orders from Nurse Practitioners**

The Board reviewed information regarding federal regulations that prohibit an APRN from obtaining reimbursement to certify plans of treatment in a home health setting. Apparently the federal regulations do not allow individuals, other than a physician, to certify plans of care in the home health setting.

Ms. Geesey requested a copy of the information for the APRN Task Force attempting to identify laws and regulations that restrict an APRN's practice.

#### **Letter from the U.S. Department of Justice, Drug Enforcement Agency (“DEA”) – Hawaii NPs Prescribing Controlled Substances and DEA Registration**

The EO reported that she received written confirmation from the DEA recognizing Hawaii APRNs as having prescriptive authority for controlled substances. She stated that the DEA web page has also been finally updated to allow Hawaii APRNs to register with the DEA online.

#### **NCSBN – NCLEX Request**

After some discussion, the Board deferred this request to the Education Committee.

#### Old Business:

#### **Amendments to HAR Title 16, Chapter 89 – Status Report**

The EO reported that the proposed amendments were transmitted to the Office of the Attorney General after signed by the Licensing Administrator and the Director of DCCA.

The EO reminded the Board that NCSBN would be doing a presentation on NURSYS at their February 2, 2012 meeting.
