Call to Order: The Chair called the meeting to order at 8:33 a.m. at which time quorum was established.

The Chair excused Dr. Kula and asked the audience to introduce themselves.

Approval of the Minutes: The Chair called for a motion in regards to the regular minutes of the November 1, 2012 meeting.

Ms. Stone Murai stated that on page 3, paragraph 6, it should read, "Ms. Stone Murai stated that she just wants to make sure that he channels of communication between the Board and the HSCFN are kept open.

There being no further amendments or discussion, upon a motion by Dr. Fleming, seconded by the Vice Chair, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve the November 1, 2012 minutes as amended.

The Chair called for a motion in regards to the executive session minutes of the November 1, 2012 meeting.

There being no discussion, upon a motion by the Vice Chair, seconded by Ms. Stone Murai, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve the November 1, 2012 executive session minutes as circulated.

Chair's Report:

The Chair reported that he met with Dr. Gardner, Executive Director for the Hawaii State Center for Nursing ("HSCFN") at which time they discussed concerns over the HSCFN survey and the lack of collaboration between the Board and the HSCFN.

The Chair stated that apparently, since the Health Resources and Services Administration ("HRSA") is no longer conducting its national surveys, there is a need for the workforce data. Thus, many other organizations are attempting to fill the void. He stated that he did inform Dr. Gardner that a link to HSCFN's survey will be included before and after the online renewal process. He and Dr. Gardner further discussed the reason/justification for having the workforce data. He also stated that the HSCFN is planning on submitting legislation requiring the completion of the survey before a nurse can renew the nurse's license.

The DAG then asked if there are any states that mandate or require the licensees to complete a survey in order to renew their licenses?

The Chair stated that according to the NCSBN, there are none.

Dr. Fleming questioned the benefit of the HRSA survey. The surveys in the past have not predicted shortages nor have the surveys addressed oversupply of nurses. Dr. Fleming queried whether such surveys are warranted and their merit.

The Chair stated that no one can show what the data has done in the past or what it will do in the future so the question is who will fill the void of HRSA and receive grant monies.

The Chair also stated that he encouraged Dr. Gardner to attend the Board meetings to discuss the issues with the Board.

Vice Chair's Report:

Medscape article, "The Nursing Workforce.. A Comparison of Three National Surveys"

Copies of the article were distributed to the Board members for their information

The Vice Chair stated that this article relates to what was previously discussed as it discusses alternatives for nursing workforce data from 2 U.S. Census Bureau surveys and how they compare with the information collected in the HRSA survey.

Executive Officer's Report:

2013 Legislature

The EO stated that she has added this subject to her report in anticipation of the upcoming Legislative Session and that to date, she has not received confirmation of any legislative affecting the nursing practice act.

Report on Attendance at NCSBN Operations Conference

The EO reported on her attendance at the NCSBN Operations Conference. The EO reported that she attended the conference with the Professional and Vocational Exam and Licensing Branch Chief, Dawn Kubota and that they both thought the topics of the conference was very informative.

Some of the relevant topics included NURSUS and urging participation in both the submission of licensee data and disciplinary actions, having the ability to communicate with other member Boards on a daily basis, and NURSUS as a "tool" for member boards. There was also an interesting session on a "paperless system".

The EO stated that she will be working with Ms. Kubota to explore some of these initiatives and ideas that would help streamline the applications process.

Ms. Elvenia stated that she would be attending the 2013 NCSBN Annual Institute of Regulatory Excellence Conference, January 15-17, 2013 in New Orleans.

Ms. Stone Murai stated that she would be attending the NCSBN Annual Meeting.

Ms. Cohen arrived at 9:10 a.m.

Education Committee
Report (Denise Cohen):

Ms. Cohen reported that the Education Committee met after the Board meeting on November 1, 2012 and made the following recommendations:

- Accept the annual reports for the following nursing programs: Hawaii Community College, University of Phoenix, Kauai Community College, UH@Manoa, UH@Manoa – MEPN, Chaminade, UH-Maui College, UH-Hilo and Hawaii Pacific University;
- Accept the quarterly reports for Hawaii Pacific University, University of Phoenix and Hawaii Community College; and
- Accepted the change of curriculum for Kapiolani Community College for the AS in Nursing Transition Program.

The Committee also continued their review and discussion on the administrative rules and propose the following amendments:

- For clarification, amend the § 16-89-2, definition of "Contact hour" to read as follows:

"Contact hour" means ~~a minimum of~~ sixty minutes of actual organized instruction. Contact hour equivalencies shall be as follows:

(1) 1 continuing education unit = 10 contact hours;

(2) 1 continuing medical education credit = 60 minutes.

Academic credit will be converted to contact hours as follows:

(1) One quarter academic credit equals 12.5 contact hours; and

(2) One semester academic credit equals 15 contact hours.

~~[Contact hour equivalencies shall be as follows: 1 continuing education unit = 10 contact hours; 1 continuing medical education credit = 60 minutes; 1 American Medical Association credit = 60 minutes.]~~

- For clarification, amend the definition of "Continuing education" to read as follows:

"Continuing education" consists of ~~a refresher course in subchapter 18~~ only educational activities that serve to maintain, develop, or increase the knowledge, skills, and professional performance and relationships a nurse uses to provide services for patients, the public, or the profession. The content of continuing education is that body of knowledge and skills generally recognized and accepted

by the profession as within the basic nursing sciences, the discipline of clinical medicine, and the provision of health care to the public. The goal for any continuing education activity is to improve patient care.

- For clarification, amend § 16-89-132(b)(3) to read as follows:
Successfully complete a ~~[refresher]~~ board approved continuing education course or courses ~~[which must first be approved by the board]~~. The course shall consist of at least ~~[eighty (80)]~~ sixty clock hours of didactic and ~~[eighty (80)]~~ sixty clock hours of clinical practice recognized by an approved provider and designed for the practical nurse or registered nurse who is returning to practice after more than five years absence from nursing practice. The nurse shall submit appropriate documentation to verify successful completion of the ~~[refresher]~~ continuing education course.
- Delete §16 89-132(d) since already defined under §16 89-2, under the definition of "Contact hour".

Ms. Cohen also reported that the Committee recommends that AMA Category II CEs are not applicable to nurses.

Upon a motion by Mr. Hoban, seconded by the Vice Chair, it was voted on and unanimously carried to accept the Education Committee's report and recommendations.

Old Business:

Amendments to HAR Tile 16, Chapter 89 – Status Report

The EO reported that the latest draft is still at the Governor's Office for request to hold a public hearing and that on Monday she will be attending the Small Business Regulatory Review Board's ("SBRRB") meeting because the proposed rules are on the agenda. She will be there to summarize and respond to any questions the SBRRB may have on the proposed rules.

Participation in NURSYS – Status Report

The EO reported that she is planning to complete submission of the disciplinary actions taken in 2012 and 2011 by the end of the year.

Criminal Background Checks

The Chair stated that the Board should think about criminal background checks as a license requirement. The discussions regarding the background checks are of concern with the compact states and national licensure but he knows that employers require a criminal background check but not sure if all employers do.

Ms. Cohen replied that private physician's who employ an RN may not do a background check.

Hawaii State Center for Nursing

The Chair stated that Dr. Gardner emailed that she is unable to attend today's meeting due to other commitments but will try to attend the Board's January meeting to provide updates on the Center's activities.

Executive Session: At 9:25 a.m., upon a motion by the Chair, seconded by Mr. Hoban it was voted on and unanimously carried to move into Executive Session in accordance with HRS, 92-5(a) (1) and (4), "To consider and evaluate personal information relating to individuals applying for professional or vocational licenses cited in section 26-9 or both;" and "To consult with the board's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities".

At 9:39 a.m., upon a motion by the Vice Chair, seconded by Ms. Stone Murai, it was voted on and unanimously carried to move out of executive session.

Ms. Fletcher stated that she would like to address the Board and informed the Board that when she went to the courts to obtain her copies of her prior conviction, she was told that she didn't have to report it to the Board because it was a misdemeanor. She tried calling our office but could not get through. When she came to drop off her application, the person at the counter informed her that she had to report it, so she wanted to let the Board know how she got conflicting information.

The EO explained that the courts do not determine what is reportable to the Board and that all "convictions" whether it is a misdemeanor or felony, must be reported to the Board as only the Board has the authority to determine if an applicant is fit to hold a license.
