1. Call to Order:	There being a quorum present, Chair Lui called the meeting to order at 8:34 a.m.
2. <u>Additions/</u> <u>Revisions to</u> <u>Agenda</u> :	None.
3. <u>Introduction of</u> <u>Keali'i S. Lopez,</u> <u>Director, DCCA</u> :	Director Lopez thanked the members for their time and effort to serve the public. She recently spoke to the Governor who also expressed his appreciation for the boards. She noted that the Board helps the DCCA with their responsibility to protect consumers. She informed the Board that the DCCA will be conducting an

7. <u>New Business:</u> a. <u>Discussion on "Capping" and "Steering" business practices</u>

Chair Lui summarized the Board's previous discussion on this issue.

DAG Tam said he met with the Board's DAG regarding this issue. He cited HRS §459-9(5) and Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") §16-92-52(5) as sections that prohibit activities such as fee splitting, commissions, etc.

b. <u>Discussion on the Association of Regulatory Boards of Optometry ("ARBO") OE</u> <u>Tracker</u>

Chair Lui summarized the Board's previous discussion on this issue.

DAG Tam asked how the submission process would work.

Chair Lui said that the licensee would be required to submit all continuing education ("CE") certificates to the ARBO OE Tracker. The course information can be submitted either by the licensee or the course provider. The licensee will have limited access to the OE Tracker for free. Full access would require the licensee to pay a \$20 annual fee. ARBO has told him that they can customize the report to suit the board's needs.

	EO Matsushima asked who would request the licensee printout.
	Chair Lui said that the EO can view the report through the board's access.
	EO Matsushima said that the law requires the licensee to provide proof that they have met the CE requirement. Using this method may require spending lots of time and effort to constantly check to see if each licensee has complied.
	Ms. Chang asked if the licensee would be able to print out a copy of their report and submit it to the Board.
	Chair Lui said he was unsure but that printing out a copy of the report may require full access to OE Tracker.
	Dr. Loo asked if all other methods of submitting proof of CE completion would not be accepted if the Board decided to adopt OE Tracker.
	EO Matsushima said it would depend on what the Board decides.
	Dr. Reynolds suggested getting more information about the OE Tracker program so the Board can better discuss the pros and cons involved. He said he feels there may be merit to the idea, however, there are too many unanswered questions to make an informed decision.
	Chair Lui asked Dr. Reynolds if he would be willing to do research on the program and report back to the Board.
	Dr. Reynolds agreed.
