Scope:

a. Request for Exemption From the Required Pest Control License for the Installation of Bird Spikes from James Richardson,
Administrator, State of Hawaii Department of Accounting and General Services

The Central Services Division of the Department of Accounting & General Services is in the process of soliciting competitive bids for the cleaning of all exterior windows at the State Capitol. The bid package includes the installation of 32 stainless steel bird spikes to decrease pigeons from roosting on the horizontal ribs.

The administrator, James Richardson is requesting an exemption since the nature of the work appears to be related to construction rather than typical pest control.

> Mr. Weinberg stated that the Board should grant the exemption if the installation of the bird spikes is as specified in the letter.

After discussion, it was moved by Vice Chairperson Fukuyama, seconded by Mr. Kobashigawa to deny the request for an exemption based solely on the information provided in the letter and the Board further confirmed that the installation of stainless spikes for the control or prevention of birds requires a pest control license BR-2 (General Pest). The motion passed with Vice Chairperson Fukuyama, Mr. Kobashigawa, Mr. Koide, and Ms. Nakasone voting "yes" and Mr. Weinberg voting "nay".

<u>Unfinished</u> Business:

a. Termite Inspection Report Standards

The Executive Officer distributed to the Board members the adopted proposed standards for a Termite Inspection dated 10/30/12 for the Board's review if further revisions are necessary. Being none, it was moved by Mr. Fukuyama, seconded by Mr. Kobashigawa and unanimously carried to adopt this draft and move to the next step in the Rules revision process.

b. Rule Revisions:

1) HAR §16-94-17

The Executive Officer distributed the current drafts of HAR §§ 16-94-17 and asked that the Board review it if further revisions are necessary. This item was deferred to the next meeting.

2) HAR §16-94-25.1

The Executive Officer also distributed HAR §16-94-25.1, Draft 9/17/12, which included the request by RICO to clarify that a pest control entity shall have an RME at all times. Mr. Weinberg asked if an entity can borrow an RME? The Executive Officer responded, "no". An RME can only be an RME for one entity unless;

- a) There is a common ownership of at least 51%,
- b) The firms are a subsidiary of or a joint venture with the other entity,
- c) There is a direct family relationship between the RME and the officers of each additional entity; and
- d) Board approval is received.

The Executive Officer added that if the entity loses an RME, the company can still fulfill current contracts but cannot enter into new contracts without an RME, but clear rule authority is needed.

It was moved by Mr. Weinberg, seconded by Mr. Koide, and unanimously carried to approve the 9/17/12 Draft of HAR §16-94-25.1.

The Executive Officer indicated that she will have the draft converted to Ramseyer and proceed to the next rule making step.
