Call to Order: The Chair called the meeting to order at 8:04 a.m.

Chair's Report: **Approval of the Previous Minutes – April 18, 2013 meeting**

The Chair called for a motion for the minutes of the April 18, 2013 meeting.

Upon a motion by Mr. Brown, seconded by the Chair, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve the minutes of the April 18, 2013 meeting as circulated.

HRS §461-15
Miscellaneous Permits:

Review of the current miscellaneous permit categories

The Committee continued their discussion on the miscellaneous permit categories listed under HRS 461-15.

The Chair submitted the following list of activities for discussion:

- Out-of-state pharmacies (dispensing)
- Out-of-state pharmacies (non-dispensing, e.g. remote order entry, MTM, etc.)

- Medical oxygen distributors
- Sterile compounding pharmacies (USP 797)
- Medical devices
- Reverse distributors
- Pharmacy benefit managers
- Out-of-state wholesale distributors

The EO submitted the following list of activities for discussion:

- Remote order entry/review
- Medical oxygen distributors
- Internet pharmacies
- Reverse distributors
- Durable medical equipment provider

Mr. Brown also wanted to discuss pharmacies that operate pixis or automated dispensing machines, not remote dispensing and mail order pharmacies.

The Chair stated that for discussion purposes, he thinks we should categorize the activities into "dispensing" vs. "non-dispensing" activities and also for discussion purposes, "in-state" or "resident" pharmacies vs. "out-of-state" or "non-resident" pharmacies. He also stated that perhaps the Committee should discuss compounding pharmacies, sterile vs. non-sterile for in-state pharmacies.

After some discussion, the Committee came up with the following list of activities for in-state and out-of-state entities, to be further discussed:

- Non-dispensing pharmacies
- Pharmacies
- Medical oxygen distributor/devices
- Wholesale distributors
- Reverse distributors
- Durable Medical Equipment Providers
- Mobile pharmacies
- Pixis or automated dispensing machines
- Nuclear pharmacies
- Compounding pharmacies

The Committee members will be researching the NABP Model Act and Rules and other states' regulations for language on these activities and continue their discussion on whether to include these activities under the miscellaneous permit or to have its own license or permit.
