Call to Order: There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order at

10:00 a.m. by Chairperson Conboy.

Agenda: None.

Introduction of Keali`i S. Lopez, Director of the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs ("DCCA") introduced herself to the committee.

<u>Director, DCCA</u>: Ms. Lopez noted that she wanted to discuss the regulation of

> Appraisal Management Companies ("AMCs"), and the reconfirmation by this committee to wait for the Federal Government ("Feds") to promulgate rules before introducing state legislation.

Mr. Walther stated that AMCs focus on residential appraisals and that the regulation of AMCs was passed to ensure compliance with appraiser independence. He commented that appraisers may not believe AMCs are being fair because they are the middle man.

Vice-Chairperson Cool commented that there may be AMCs who may not be familiar with the market in their review process. He further commented that it would be challenging for a state to introduce rules to regulate AMCs, and that it may be difficult for each state to follow a national model.

Chairperson Conboy commented that the legislature may introduce bills to regulate AMCs without the full understanding of the profession. Ms. Lopez stated that DCCA's administrative bills are due by September and that if the Feds pass their rules by the ending of this year, as planned, then the DCCA will have added pressure to have our own draft rules in place.

Discussion ensued on the rise of complaints received in the last two years by the Regulated Industries Complaints Office. Vice-Chairperson Cool commented that the rise in number of complaints may be relative to the increase in volume of appraisal related services; therefore, the percentage from the volume may be the same compared to prior years. DAG Paige commented that the increase in volume of appraisal related services may be due to the real estate foreclosures, especially in the Mainland market.

Discussion ensued on Act 227, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011, which would require appraisers, while acting as arbitrators, to certify compliance with the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice and be required to provide a written report explaining their findings as part of the final arbitration award. Ms. Lopez inquired of any outcomes due to Act 227; Vice-Chairperson Cool commented that it has no effect for him; and also that there is uncertainty on the record of the reward; tending to weaken arbitration. Ms. Lopez commented that Act 227 may have been enacted for business planning, for others to strategize the lease rent. The committee members were not aware of any negative impacts due to this Act.

Ms. Lopez expressed her appreciation to Chairperson Conboy and Ms. Kaku for serving on this committee, as both members' term expire on June 30, 2013.
