ORDER OF BUSINESS


Determination of Residence -
Charles F. Brown, Salesman's
Applicant

Mr. Charles F. Brown, successful applicant for a real estate salesman's license was given an opportunity to appear before the Commission to determine whether he qualified as a resident of the Territory of Hawaii, as required under Section 7737, Chapter 150, Revised Laws of Hawaii, as amended 1953.

Upon the testimony given by Mr. Brown and Mr. Bolles, sponsoring broker, the Commission unanimously voted to deny a salesman's license to Mr. Brown on the grounds that he has failed to prove to the Commission his true intent or declaration to become a bona fide resident of the Territory of Hawaii.
