#### Rulemaking, Chapter 107

Staff is currently in the process of drafting a first draft of rules in relation to Chapter 514B for the committee's review in approximately three months. The rules for Chapter 514A were initially drafted in 2002 and held in abeyance since recodification was contemplated. Those rules will also be updated by staff.

Chair Loudermilk informed the committee that Staff will be taking the lead in drafting the rules to keep the process moving forward.

	Legislative Acts and Resolutions – SR 113, HR 128 (2009) - Survey Results - Electronic Filing of CPR Projects
	Specialist Yee reported that surveys were distributed randomly to developers, developers' attorneys, consultants and other state agencies. The deadline for survey submission was April 29, 2010. Staff will provide a more detailed report on the responses received at its next meeting.
	Commissioner Kuriyama noted that the Commission should take into account the voluminous size of the public report documents submitted to the Commission for review by its consultants and careful reviewing of all documentation submitted that is required. In looking at other agencies and their responses, we need to note the size of their documents submitted to their system, the review needed to be made and what that agency then does with the documents.
