Condominium Project Related Articles

The following article and legislation were distributed for informational purposes: "Minnesota Legislators, REALTORS® and Land Title Industry Call on Governor Pawlenty to Ban Wall Street Resale Fees" *American Land Title Association May 19, 2010*, and House Bill 2288 HD1, SD2, CD1, relating to private transfer fees.

Program of Work: Condominium Laws and Education

Specialist Yee briefed the committee about the Condominium Education Trust Fund's free seminar held at the State Capitol Auditorium on May 27, 2010. The free seminar was designed to elaborate for condominium unit owners and board Condominium Review Committee Minutes of the June 9, 2010 Meeting Page 4

> members the information included in Commission's recently published booklets, "Owners Rights and Responsibilities" and "Board Duties and Responsibilities." In an attempt to conserve fiscal resources but also trying to reach as many people as possible, staff contacted 350 AOUO's contact persons via email and sent out media press releases through the department. Unfortunately, attendance was low (27). However staff worked with Olelo and was able to tape the seminar. After compiling the Olelo filming, the seminar may be broadcasted over one of Olelo's cable channels. Neighbor Island residents may be able to get a copy of the seminar through a request to Olelo.

Pilot Project – "Visiting Condominium Specialist"

A sample request form of the on-site Educational Outreach Program for Condominium Owners and Board Members was distributed for the committee's information. Staff targeted the month of July 2010 to launch this pilot program and will focus on those groups with multiple condominium associations present.

Hawaii Condominium Bulletin

The committee reviewed the HePS bids received for the writing, editing, and layout of the Hawaii Condominium Bulletin and Real Estate Commission Bulletin. After a review of the 5 bids received, the committee decided to award the contract to the lowest bidder Hagadone Printing for \$6400.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Aiona, seconded by Commissioner Gendrano, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve the award for the writing, editing, and layout of the Hawaii Condominium and Real Estate Commission Bulletins to Hagadone Printing for \$6400 subject to the terms and conditions of the solicitation.

Rulemaking, Chapter 107

Specialist Yee indicated that staff will attempt to have portions of the draft condominium rules for the committee's review and comments at subsequent CRC meetings. Once all comments and suggestions are received, staff will compile them at the end of the drafting process, followed by the formal rulemaking procedures including but not limited to the Attorney General's review, Governor's approval and public hearings.

Legislative Acts and Resolutions -- SR 113, HR 128 (2009) – Electronic Survey Results

Specialist Leong reported that staff is still in the process of compiling the results of the survey and drafting a report of the results.

Program of Work, FY11

The committee having reviewed the draft proposed program of work for fiscal year 2011 voted to approve the fiscal year 2011 program of work as proposed.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Nishihara, seconded by Commissioner Suiso, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve the program of work and budget for fiscal year 2011.
