Minutes:	Upon a motion by Commissioner Aiona, seconded by Commissioner Abrams, it was voted on and unanimously carried to accept the minutes of the November 4, 2009 Condominium Review Committee meeting as circulated.

Governance and Management:	Specialist Stone reported that as of November 30, 2009, 1,553 AOUOs have successfully registered.			
	Condominium Seminars and Symposium – "3 <sup>rd</sup> and final 'option' to renew existing contract with Community Associations Institute Hawaii Chapter for the development and delivery of educational seminars"			
	The committee discussed its option to exercise the Commission's 3 <sup>rd</sup> and final option to renew the CAI Hawaii contract from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. The services were procured through HEPS.			
	Staff conducted a non-statistical evaluation of the participants' surveys submitted by CAI Hawaii to date.			
	Staff noted that most of the returned surveys were positive. The returned surveys included ones from registered associations. Staff also reported that last year, the Condominium Council of Maui expressed interest in offering condominium seminars. Oral and written information on registering with HEPS at that time was provided.			
	Upon a motion by Commissioner Abrams, seconded by Commissioner Suiso, it was voted on and unanimously carried to exercise the Commission's 3 <sup>rd</sup> and final option to renew its contract with CAI Hawaii Chapter for one fiscal year, July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011.			

It was also suggested that staff discuss with CAI Hawaii the possibility of increasing its marketing efforts to increase the percentage of condominium owner attendees who are not board members and to increase the percentage of offerings planned specifically for condominium owners who are not board members.
