Specialist Yee reported that staff has been meeting with an industry group of mediation providers, property managers, and attorneys on the Condominium Dispute Resolution program. The group is looking into recommendations to change the mediation process and may come before the Commission seeking CMEF/CETF subsidy for a different model of mediation.

#### **Condominium Laws and Education** Program of Work:

The selected contractor for the brochure updates, Ekimoto and Morris, LLLC, has submitted their draft updates of the brochures "Condominium Board Member Powers and Duties" and "Condominium Owner Rights and Responsibilities" which will be circulated for review and comments.

# **Condominium Specialist Office for the Day**

Condominium Specialists in conjunction with the real estate renewal workshops have been holding the condominium specialist office for the day at the various neighbor island sites. There were no participants at the Kona site.

### **Condominium Reference Library**

Staff has received word from CAI Hawaii and will participate in the circulation of the reference materials to the selected libraries. The Commission will also purchase additional reference materials to distribute to the Mediation Center of the Pacific and other locations as selected by the Commission. Staff will include the REC approved caveat language in all copies of the reference materials.

### Rulemaking Chapter 53, Fees

It was reported to the committee that based on staff's budget projections, it appears the condominium management education fund and the condominium education trust fund will run a deficit. The committee reviewed the historical and projected information provided by staff relating to the CMEF/CETF.

#### **Executive Session:**

Upon a motion by Commissioner Abrams, seconded by Commissioner Gendrano, it was voted on and unanimously carried to enter into executive session pursuant to section 92-5(a)(4), HRS, "To consult with the board's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities and liabilities."

Upon a motion by Commissioner Suiso, seconded by Commissioner Gendrano, it was voted on and unanimously carried to move out of executive session.

Chair Chee appointed Vice Chair Suiso to work with staff on the budget issue and report back to the next Condominium Review Committee meeting his recommendations and suggestions to address the issue.

SEO Fujitani explained to those present that the Condominium Management Education Fund / Condominium Education Trust Fund which funds educational programs pursuant to the original condominium statute and the recodified Chapter 514B, HRS, will be running into a deficit in the year 2015 or as early as 2012 depending on which projection is used as a basis. The committee discussed a number of ways to fix the shortfall.
