Upon a motion by Commissioner Kagawa, seconded by Commissioner Abrams, it was voted on and unanimously carried to recommend approval of Jay J. Spadinger as an independent study course instructor for the salesperson curriculum.

<u>Prelicense Independent Study Course – Dower School of Real Estate Windward,</u> <u>David Catanzaro, Principal, Salesperson and Broker Curricula</u>

Upon a motion by Commissioner Abrams, seconded by Commissioner Okawa, it was voted on and unanimously carried to recommend approval of Dower School of Real Estate Windward to offer the salesperson and broker curricula independent study course.

Senior Specialist Fujimura stated that Dower School of Real Estate Windward is the third school to offer the 80-hour broker course and the second to offer it via independent study.

Independent Study Course Instructor – David Catanzaro, Dower School of Real Estate Windward

Upon a motion by Commissioner Imanaka, seconded by Commissioner Kagawa, it was voted on and unanimously carried to recommend approval of David Catanzaro as an independent study course instructor for the broker and salesperson curricula.

#### Salesperson's Curriculum

#### Update - First Draft

Janice Lind, Hawaii Academy of Real Estate, distributed the first draft of the salesperson curriculum revision. Ms. Lind reported that the first draft is based on the current salesperson curriculum and portions of the broker curriculum, but has some significant changes included. The changes include an increased emphasis on ethics as the base and underlying foundation of the agency relationship, more focus on agency relationships and their various forms, more time allotted to practical applications including HAR standard forms, and less time spent on specialized areas of the law (Hawaii Revised Statutes) including Chapters 436B, 514A and 514E, and the subdivision laws. She stated that this is a starting point and looks forward to reviewing the first draft at Friday's EETF meeting. She noted that they want to keep it within a reasonable amount of time.

Ms. Lind added that the survey revealed that there may be a need for more basics. SEO Kimura inquired if there were any comments on post licensing education. Ms. Lind responded that their overview discusses this issue—the prelicensing curriculum should be a base. SEO Kimura stated that there is a trend on placing more emphasis on post licensing requirements—you develop a

more professional group of licensees as they have to make a bigger commitment. Ms. Lind concluded that there is a need to turn individuals out that are ready to work, not just able to pass the exam. Vice Chair Nishihara thanked Ms. Lind. Administration of Promissor Examinations: Licensing Examination Statistics Examination statistics for January 2005 was distributed to the Commissioners for their information. February 2005 School Summary Reports The February 2005 School Summary Reports are not currently available as Promissor was experiencing technical problems. **Test Development and Scenario Exam Items** Specialist Kimura reported that Promissor will be conducting a net meeting to review the uniform portion of the exam and requested that Hawaii be an active participant. Commissioner Nishihara has agreed to participate for one day and Commissioner Abrams has agreed to participate for two days. Once this is concluded, Promissor will be conducting a Standard Setting Meeting on Friday, May 6, 2005 at the Promissor headquarters in Philadelphia. Upon a motion by Commissioner Okawa, seconded by Commissioner Kagawa, it was voted on and unanimously carried to recommend approval to send one person to the Standard Setting Meeting to be held at Promissor headquarters, Philadelphia, PA, on May 6, 2005. Hawaii Association of REALTORS® - No discussion presented. Educator's Forum: Hawaii Association of Real Estate Schools (HARES) - No discussion presented. Public and Private Institutions of Higher Education - No discussion presented. Program of Work: Annual Report, Quarterly Bulletin, and School Files School Files - April 2005 Senior Specialist Fujimura reported that she is currently working on the April 2005 issue of School Files and hopes to have it distributed soon. **Neighbor Island Outreach** Big Island, June 2005 The next neighbor island outreach is scheduled for Kona on the island of Hawaii on June 14, 2005.

Ms. Shimizu added that they have received a lot of questions on technology and they will be partnering with the Honolulu Board of REALTORS<sup>®</sup> and the Hawaii CRS Chapter to sponsor a technology fair in August. They will be bringing in three experts to speak and will also have a trade show with different vendors, including a user group session.
