SEO Fujitani noted that Senator Baker announced as Chair of the Commerce and Consumer Protection committee that she takes seriously consumer protection and that the proposed amendments in Senate Bill No. 3002 would cause harm to the consumer. Commissioner Ball met with Senator Baker and the affected parties to work on a resolution to the bill. The final language of the bill was agreed to by all parties.
