

Minimum Qualification Specifications
for the Class:

SPRINKLER SYSTEM REPAIRER

Experience Requirements

Applicants must have had one year of work experience in repairing and/or installing ground water sprinkler systems which demonstrate that the applicant has knowledge of: operating principles of manual and automatic control water sprinkler systems; basic principles of electricity as related to electric current continuity in electric automatic water sprinkler systems; tools, equipment and materials used in installing, servicing and repairing manual and electric automatic sprinkler systems; and safe work methods and procedures applicable in the repair, maintenance and installation of water sprinkler systems; and the ability to: diagnose and locate malfunctions; repair, maintain and install sprinkler systems including the remote control valves of electrical automatic sprinkler systems; use tools and equipment, including multimeters, in the repair and maintenance of sprinkler systems; prepare work reports; work from and interpret sketches and diagrams; and follow oral and written instructions.

Quality of Experience

Possession of the required number of years of experience will not in itself be accepted as proof of qualification for a position. The applicant's overall experience must have been of such scope and level of responsibility as to conclusively demonstrate that he/she has the ability to perform the duties of the position for which he/she is being considered.

License Required

Applicants must possess a valid license to drive in the State of Hawaii.

Tests

Applicants may be required to qualify on an appropriate examination.

Physical and Medical Requirements

Applicants must be able to perform the essential functions of the position effectively and safely, with or without reasonable accommodation.

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This is an amendment to the minimum qualification specifications for the class, SPRINKLER SYSTEM REPAIRER, which were approved on May 6, 1989.
