# EQUAL OPPORTUNITY

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act, the Age Discrimination Act, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, and Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act provide that no person shall, on the basis of race, color, national origin, age, or disability be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance.
