**PUBLIC NOTICE**

The Department of Human Services will discontinue the Hawai'i Rx Plus discount card program for prescription medications effective August 1, 2010. Initiated in July 2004, the program enabled the State to make prescription drugs more affordable for qualified lower-income Hawai'i residents.

Since then, the Medicare Part D federal program and the availability of many free or more generous prescription discount programs to all residents of Hawaii, without eligibility restrictions, render the program obsolete.

The Department encourages all residents, including those enrolled and using Hawai'i Rx Plus to call or download free discount cards from other prescription discount program, including:
