Act 209

In accordance with Act 209 SLH 2005, the Department of Human Services (DHS) is submitting this annual report to the State Legislature on the enrollment and financial status of the State Pharmacy Assistance Program (SPAP).

I. Enrollment

Approximately 26,000 Hawaii residents who meet the eligibility requirements under law will be automatically enrolled into the SPAP and issued SPAP cards by December 31, 2005.

II. Expenditures and Financial Status

There are no funds in the SPAP Special Fund to date. The State will contract with a Third Party Administrator to administer this program and cover the costs associated with the program by December 31, 2005.
