## **REPORT ON ACT 13, SESSION LAWS OF HAWAII 2009**

Act 13, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, requires the Department of Human Services (DHS) to submit to the legislature a report of its findings and recommendations no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2011.

Act 13 (SLH 2009) allowed DHS to establish and implement a two-year project for two private pay individuals under certain limited circumstances to occupy the same community care foster family home (CCFFH) when the home is certified for three nursing level of care individuals.

The report is to include the monitoring and evaluation of the demonstration project for its impact on the availability of space for Medicaid clients during this two-year demonstration project.

### **Findings:**

From April 22, 2009 until September 30, 2010, the DHS have received one request, for two private pay individuals to live in the same CCFFH. The requirements of Act 13 (SLH 2009) were met and the placement was approved.

No other requests have been submitted.

There has been no impact on the available Medicaid space during the term of this act.
