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The **Water Resource Bulletin** is published monthly to provide timely notice of important events under the purview of the Commission. 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#### A. New Notices

- In an effort to provide more timely and cost-effective notices, we have updated our Bulletin to be more user friendly in finding applications which may be of interest to our readers. We have also included a letter offering our subscribers the option to receive future Bulletins via e-mail, and we are posting the Bulletin on our new web site, URL <http://www.hawaii.gov/dlnr/dworm/dworm.html>.
  - The Commission on Water Resource Management has selected Frank D. Padgett as its independent legal counsel for the Waiahole Ditch Contested Case Hearing (Case No. CCH-OA-95-1) appeal.
  - On January 23, 1997, the Commission approved the 'Hawaii Well Construction and Pump Installation Standards' which provide minimum standards for such work. As part of this approval, the Commission delegated authority to the Chairperson to approve: 1) well construction permits statewide, and 2) pump installation permits in aquifer systems that are not designated water management areas and where estimated water usage is less than 70% of sustainable yield. Additionally, unless deemed otherwise by the Chairperson, no additional permit application is required statewide for the replacement of pumps less than or equal to the existing pump capacity. All applications will be listed in this Bulletin, and approval dates may reflect Chairperson approval or Commission approval.

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## C. Petitions for Reservation of Water in Water Management Areas

- **Res - OA93-1** - The State Department of Agriculture (DOA) filed a complete petition for reservation of 47.60 mgd of water flowing in Waiahole Ditch for agricultural uses on lands in Central and Windward Oahu.
- **Res - OA94-2** - The Office of Hawaiian Affairs' Committee on Land and Sovereignty has filed a complete petition to reserve 11 mgd of water from the Waiahole Ditch for present and future Hawaiian uses in the Waiahole area.
- **Res - OA94-3** - The Kahaluu Neighborhood Board, Waiahole Waikane Community Association and the Hakipuu Ohana have filed a complete petition for the reservation of all of the water from the Waiahole Ditch that is developed on the Windward side of Oahu, for agricultural uses.
- **Res - OA94-4** - The Kamehameha Schools/Bernice Pauahi Bishop Estate has filed a complete petition to reserve all of the waters originating from the ahupua'a of Waiawa (estimated to be 4.2 mgd) that flow in the Waiahole Ditch. The stated purpose is to serve future development on seven parcels of land in the Waiawa area.
- **Res - OA95-1** - The State Department of Hawaiian Home Lands has filed a complete petition to reserve an estimated 410,000 gallons per day of water from Waiahole Stream to serve its beneficiaries on five parcels of land (some 82 acres) in Waiahole.
- **Res - OA95-2** - The State Division of State Parks has filed a water reservation of an estimated 0.125 mgd of water from Kahana Stream to serve agricultural programs and residential lessees' subsistence agricultural permits in Kahana Valley State Park. This reservation is not presently part of the Waiahole Ditch combined contested case.
- **Res - OA97-2** - The State Department of Hawaiian Home Lands has filed a completed petition to reserve an additional 2.303 mgd of groundwater from the Waipahu-Waiawa Aquifer System for foreseeable needs in the Waianae, Ewa, Honolulu, and Koolau-poko Districts.
- **Res - OA97-3** - The State Department of Hawaiian Home Lands has filed a completed petition to amend Administrative Rule 13-171-62 to reduce the reservation for the Waimanalo Aquifer System by 0.027 mgd. (This petition was made pursuant to the Commission's action at the June 5, 1997 meeting wherein 0.027 mgd of ground water from the Waipahu-Waiawa Aquifer System was allocated for Waimanalo homestead areas.)

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## D. Petitions for the Designation of Water Management Areas

- **Ahupua'a of Punalu'u as a Surface Water Management Area** - On January 20, 1994, the Punalu'u Community Association (PCA) filed a petition "in order to protect surface water including stream flow, to guarantee the statutory rights of kuleana land owners as well as the riparian and appurtenant rights of others and also to preserve and protect the agricultural base and natural habitats which depend on such surface water." Moreover, PCA alleges ongoing "serious disputes". On March 16, 1994, the Commission approved continuing the designation process to investigate and determine the need for designation.
- **Ahupua'a of Laie as a Surface Water Management Area** - On May 13, 1996, Dawn Wasson, et. al filed a petition citing diminishing surface water supply for future needs and serious disputes occurring within the area. Decision-making for continuing the process is deferred pending results of Laie CCH-OA96-2, which has been completed on December 7, 1998.
- **Island of Molokai** - On March 28, 1990, 39 individuals filed a petition to designate Molokai as both Ground and Surface Water Management Areas. On May 13, 1992 the Commission designated Molokai and its 16 aquifer systems as groundwater management areas. Surface water designation has been deferred pending further study.

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## E. Contested Case Hearings

- **CCH-OA96-1** - EWA MARINA CONTESTED CASE HEARING, EWA CAPROCK GROUND WATER MANAGEMENT AREA - Haseko (Ewa), Inc. proposes to develop a 1400-slip marina at Ewa, Oahu consisting of approximately 120 acres of waterways and berthing basins. The Commission, on September 25, 1998, issued the final Decision and Order approving the issuance of a water use permit to Haseko (Ewa), Inc. for the proposed excavation of the Ewa Marina, subject to standard and special conditions.
  - **CCH-OA96-2** - HAWAII RESERVES, INC., LAIE WATER COMPANY, AND POLYNESIAN CULTURAL CENTER CONTESTED CASE HEARING, KOOLAULO'A GROUND WATER MANAGEMENT AREA, OAHU - Evidentiary hearings have been held on various water use permit applications of Hawaii Reserves, Inc., Laie Water Company, and Polynesian Cultural Center. Hearing officers Herbert M. Richards, Jr. and Robert G. Girald issued the Proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Decision and Order on August 19, 1998. The parties filed written exceptions in February 1998. The Commission heard oral arguments from the parties on Friday, October 16, 1998. The final Decision and Order was issued on December 7, 1998. The Commission took action on eleven well sources, granting in part and denying in part water use permits for the sources, depending on the facts established in the hearing.
  - **CCH-MO96-1** - KAMILOLOA-WAI'OLA WELL WATER USE PERMIT (Kamiloloa System, Southeast Sector, Moloka'i Aquifer) - Moloka'i Ranch's public water utility proposes development of a well in the mauka portion of Kaunakakai ahupua'a to serve existing and future land uses at Kualapu'u Town, Maunaloa Town, Pala'au Industrial Area, and prospective Ranch land developments. Hearing Officer Richard H. Cox issued the Proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Decision and Order on August 19, 1998. The parties filed written exceptions in September 1998. The Commission heard oral arguments on the written exceptions on November 5 and 6, 1998, on Molokai. The final Decision and Order was issued on December 28, 1998. The Commission approved a water use permit for 655,928 gallons per day subject to standard and special conditions.
  - **CCH-MO97-1** - KUKUI (MOLOKA'I), INC. WELL #17 WATER USE PERMIT (Kualapu'u System, Central Sector, Moloka'i Aquifer) - Kukui (Moloka'i), Inc. requests 2.0 mgd for existing and future uses at Kaluakoi Resort. The Commission has determined that a contested case hearing is required, and has selected Peter Adler as hearing officer. The hearing began on November 23, 1998. Closing arguments were heard on December 31, 1998. The final decision will be rendered at another date.
