NOMINATIONS FOR COMMISSION MEMBER STATE COMMISSION ON WATER RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

The State Commission on Water Resource Management (“Water Commission”) Nominating Committee is soliciting nominations for two positions on the Commission. The Nominating Committee will send the names of three individuals for each position to the Governor for appointment.

- 1) Current vacancy (to be filled immediately).
- 2) July 1, 2012 vacancy (person with experience in Hawaiian water rights).

The Water Commission is composed of seven members. The Commission has jurisdiction and final authority on matters relating to the State Water Code. Five members are appointed by the Governor subject to confirmation by the State Senate. The Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources and the Director of the Department of Health are ex-officio members.

State law requires that each member have “substantial experience in the area of water resource management.” The July 2012 position must have “substantial experience or expertise in traditional Hawaiian water resource management techniques and in traditional Hawaiian riparian usage.” Members serve without pay except for reimbursement for expenses.
