Amendment to Title 13
Chapter 13-168
Hawaii Administrative Rules

SUMMARY

1. Section 13-168-12 is amended.

1. Section 13-168-12, Hawaii Administrative Rules, is amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

"(a) No well shall be constructed, altered, or repaired and no pump or pumping equipment shall be installed, replaced, or repaired without an appropriate permit from the commission. [An]Each application for a well construction or pump installation permit shall be accompanied by a non-refundable filing fee of [\$25.00] \$300.00, excepting government agencies, and shall be required for all areas of the state, including water management areas. The owner of a well shall make application or cause an application to be made by the well driller who will construct the well or by the pump installation contractor who will install the pump and pumping equipment, as the case may be."
