TMK maps showing diversion locations and water uses referenced; the end uses depicted in the second map are not drawn to scale.





Subject Waiko Road Kuleana -- LCA 460

Attached are the Mahele documents for LCA 460. This one is a little confusing, because there are 2 LCAs, both numbered 460, to the same claimant, Puupahoehoe. The first is for Apana 1 and 2, which are the ones relevant here. The second is for Apana 3, which does not appear to be. On the LCA for Apana 1 and 2, Apana 1 (L-shaped parcel sketched on left) is roughly where TMK (2) 3-5-12-7 is (refer to Attachments 1 and 2 to earlier email). A portion of Apana 2 (larger sketch on right) is where TMKs (2) 3-5-12-1 through 5 are. The other portion of Apana 2 is on the North side of what is now Waiko Road.

I have also attached the LCA 460 for Apana 3, because it may help to explain the discrepancy with the Royal Patent. So far, I have only found RP 7237, which identifies the same claimant and the same LCA number. The Land Court map, however, indicates that RP 2165 is associated with LCA 460. It may be that RP 7237 is for Apana 3 of LCA 460, and RP 2165 is for Apana 1 and 2. (That could also be the issue with LCA 3108, which is the other one where the RP No. does not match the number on the Land Court map, even though it is to the same claimant for the same LCA - or, it could just be a mistake). Since appurtenant rights would attach regardless of whether a Royal Patent was issued, I have not spent much energy trying to resolve this. I am still looking, though, for the Foreign Testimony for LCA 460.






