3. A map showing the current and the ancient water diversion systems on our Iao property
4. Our Real Property Tax 2011-2012 form showing ownership of said property
5. My birth certificate showing my Hawaiian lineage, which ensures my ancestral line back to 1778, and also ensures protection to practice my culture of growing taro, and gathering rights

As a Kanaka Maoli with ownership of kuleana lands on my Iao Valley lands, and also as owner of two fifths of a mile of Iao stream, I claim both my appurtenant and riparian water rights to these lands.




