
PUBLIC INTEREST

However, adequate provision shall be made for the protection of traditional and customary Hawaiian rights, the protection and procreation of fish and wildlife, the maintenance of proper ecological balance and scenic beauty, and the preservation and enhancement of waters of the State for municipal uses, public recreation, public water supply, agriculture, and navigation. Such objectives are declared to be in the public interest.*

Explain below how the uses in your application are consistent with the public interest as described above. Attach additional sheets if necessary.

HRS, Section 174C-2(c) indicates that the Water Code shall be interpreted to obtain the maximum beneficial use of waters for purposes of including agricultural and irrigation uses. The uses applied for fall within such categories, the same being various types of agricultural uses, i.e. fruit trees, ornamental plants, nursery and greenhouse, tree field stock nursery. Consequently such uses are consistent with the public interest provisions of the State Water Code.




