Ring-neck Pheasant Green Pheasant	Three (cocks only) per hunter, which may be of either species or a combination of these species.	First Saturday in November through Martin Luther King Day or the third Sunday in January which ever occurs later.	Saturdays, Sundays, and State Holidays	Public land and private lands . NOTE: Hunting on private lands requires a valid State of Hawaii hunting license and permission of the landowner.
Nepal Kalij Pheasant	Three birds of either sex per hunter.			
California Valley Quail Japanese Quail Gamble's Quail	Fifteen birds of either sex per hunter, which may be of any one species or a combination of these species.			
Chukar Partridge Gray Francolin Black Francolin	Eight birds of either sex per hunter, which may be of any one species or a combination of these species.			
Erckel's Francolin	Three birds of either sex per hunter.			
Chestnut bellied Sandgrouse Mourning Dove Spotted Dove (Large Dove)	Ten birds of either sex per hunter, which may be of any one species or a combination of these species.			
Barred Dove (Small Dove)	Twenty birds of either sex per hunter.			
Wild Turkey	One bird of either sex per hunter.			
SPECIAL BIRD SEASONS				
Wild Turkey (Spring Hunt only)	Two bearded birds (Gobbler only) per hunter per season. ***	March 1 through March 31.	Daily from one-half hour before sunrise to one-half hour after sunset.	Unit A, F, G, and Kipuka Ainalou** only. *Permit and tag required for public and private areas. No dogs allowed.
Barred Dove (Small Dove)	Twenty birds of either sex per hunter.	Fourth Saturday in January through last Sunday in March.	Saturdays, Sundays, and State Holidays	On private lands only with permission from the landowner.
Spotted Dove (Large Dove)	Ten birds per hunter.	First Saturday in October through the last Sunday in October.		



*** Distinct feathering characteristics unique to the male turkey are located on the upper breast.


Showing Public Hunting Areas for Game Birds on the


