Barred Dove (Small Dove)	Twenty birds of either sex per hunter.			
Spotted Dove (Large Dove)	Ten birds of either sex per hunter.

Fourth Saturday in January through the last Sunday in March; and First Saturday in October through the last Sunday in October.	Saturdays, Sundays, and State Holidays	Private lands only. Spotted Dove (Large Dove)	Ten birds of either sex per hunter.	First Saturday in October through the last Sunday in October.
