Issuance of Revocable Permit to Hawaii Explosives & Pyrotechnics, Inc. for Aerial Fireworks Display at Shipwreck Beach on January 27, 2012, Poipu, Kauai, Hawaii, Tax Map Key: (4) 2-9-01: seaward of 2.

APPLICANT:

Hawaii Explosives & Pyrotechnics, Inc., a domestic profit corporation, whose business and mailing address is P.O. Box 1244, Keaau, Hawaii 96749.

LEGAL REFERENCE:

Sections 171-55, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended.

LOCATION:

Portion of Government lands of Poipu situated at Koloa, Kauai identified by Tax Map Key: (4) 2-9-1:portion seaward of 2, as shown on the attached map labeled Exhibit A.

AREA:

500 square feet, more or less.

ZONING:

State Land Use District: Conservation

TRUST LAND STATUS:

CURRENT USE STATUS:

Vacant and unencumbered.

CHARACTER OF USE:

Set-up, firing and clean-up of aerial fireworks display purposes.

From 1:00pm to 11:30pm on January 27, 2012.

\$50.00 (Rental based on \$0.10 per square foot per day x 500 square feet)

CHAPTER 343 - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

In accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rule Sections 11-200-8(a)(1)(4) and the Exemption List for the Department of Land and Natural Resources approved by the Environmental Council and dated December 4, 1991, the subject request is exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment pursuant to Exemption Class No. 1, that states "Operations, repairs or maintenance of existing structures, facilities, equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion or change of use beyond that Previously existing" and Class No. 4, that states "Minor alteration in the conditions of land, water, or vegetation."

REMARKS:

Pursuant to the authority delegated by the Board on September 28, 2001, Item D-4, right-of-entry permits were issued for fireworks display in the past.

After discussion about different types of commercial activities and any associated requirements, staff brings the request to the Board for disposition. The form of disposition could be in form of a revocable permit.

Applicant has not had a lease, permit easement or other disposition of State lands terminated within the past five years due to non-compliance with such terms and conditions.

No comments were solicited from government or community agencies.


Hawaii Explosives & Pyrotechnics, Inc. is requesting a revocable permit for fireworks display services in conjunction with the Grand Hyatt Kauai Resort & Spa Event. The aerial fireworks display is scheduled for January 27, 2012 at Shipwreck Beach fronting the Ilima Gardens Restaurant. Set-up will start at 1:00pm and breakdown by 11:30pm. Firing time will be between 7:00pm to 9:00pm.

The proposed activity is of a similar type and scope of fireworks display activities that routinely occurred and continues to occur on this and other beach areas across the State. Such activities have in no known significant impacts whether immediate or cumulative, to the natural, environmental and/or cultural resources in the area. As such, staff believes that the proposed event/use would involve negligible or no expansion or change in use of the subject area beyond that previously existing.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board:


1. Declare that, after considering the potential effects of the proposed disposition as provided by Chapter 343, HRS, and Chapter 11-200, HAR, this project will probably have minimal or no significant effect on the environmental assessment.
2. Authorize the issuance of a revocable permit to Hawaii Explosives & Pyrotechnics, Inc. covering the subject area for aerial fireworks display purposes under the terms and conditions cited above, which are by this reference incorporated herein and further subject to the following:
 - a. The standard terms and conditions of the most current revocable permit form, as may be amended from time to time;
 - b. Review and approval by the Department of the Attorney General; and
 - c. Such other terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Chairperson to best serve the interests of the State.




